Children's Choir

All children in grades 1 and up who enjoy singing are invited to join the Children's Choir. We rehearse regularly on Monday afternoons following Faith Formation classes, and sing monthly at the 10 a.m. mass. No experience is necessary, and we know that children are busy and cannot attend every rehearsal or liturgy. All we ask is that you like to sing!

Rehearsals: Mondays when Faith Formation classes meet 4:50 – 5:20

Liturgies: October 18, November 15, December 6, December 24 (4:30 pm in the hall), January 3, February 7, March 7, and April 4 (Easter)

Cantors

Children in grades 2 and above are encouraged to try cantoring – that is, leading the congregation in prayer and song from the altar. This can be done in pairs or as a solo once the child is comfortable with the routine. We try to have one or more children cantor at each liturgy, especially when the Gloria is in season.

Why Join the Choir?

Well, for one thing it's fun – just ask anyone who sings. We're a very relaxed group! If that's not enough reason, you may consider that singing makes church more interesting. You might actually learn something and start to understand what is going on around you!

Special Liturgies

As above, children are busy and cannot manage every activity. If you want to sing and cannot make Monday rehearsals, talk to Dot about possible alternatives. Or you may want to simply join the choir for one of the extra special liturgies at Christmas and Easter.
