

PARKING AND DROP-OFF GUIDELINES (WITH MAP)

For safety considerations, St. Joseph Parish has prepared the following guidelines for parking and drop off associated with Monday afternoon faith formation classes.

Grades K-3

- ALL K-3 students must be accompanied into and out of the ***Parish Hall*** by a parent or older sibling. Please drop-off and pick-up students in the Parish Hall, NOT in the breezeway/gallery.
- Parking for K-3 drop-off/pick-up is available in the upper lot (between Wellington School and St. Joseph Church). No more room in the lot? Park at the Wellington School. PLEASE DO NOT PARK in the travel lanes or fire lane or staff parking spaces.

(And please follow the arrows for the parking lot – for safety and circulation reasons we ask that you ***do not*** enter through the exit driveway or exit through the entrance driveway.)

Grades 4-6

- 4th, 5th and 6th graders may be dropped-off and picked-up in the lower parking lot (see map). Please be sure that your child knows to meet you in the lower lot. 4th, 5th and 6th graders must remain behind the orange cones or on the sidewalk while waiting for parents. Please make a pick-up plan with your student so that they know whether to meet you in the Parish Hall or in the lower lot. They may gather their younger sibling to wait for you. (Any 4th, 5th and 6th behaving in an inappropriate manner outside will be asked to wait in the hall for a parent.)

Catechists

Please park in the lower lot in designated aisles (see map). There is adequate space for 20 catechist vehicles with clear aisles adjacent for exiting during class times if an emergency calls you away from class.

A Summary –

Upper Lot (near Wellington and St. Joseph):

- parking for K-3 and parents walking their children to/from the Parish Hall.
- **NO LIVE DROP-OFF or PICK-UP**
(Overflow parking is available at the Wellington School.)
- **DO NOT** park in **HANDICAP** or **STAFF SPACES!!!**

Lower Lot

- catechist parking
- LIVE DROP-OFF/PICK-UP for grades 4-6 with siblings.

Note:

Parents are invited to remain in the Parish Hall or to come and have a coffee and share fellowship with other parents in the Parish Library during class times.

Have smaller kids (ages 0 – 5)? Bring them to Pray ‘n Play for songs, stories, crafts, and free play from 3:45 – 4:45 in the basement play space. Just follow the signs!!
